## BOURBON

*Bourbon whiskey is a type of American whiskey: a barrel-aged distilled spirit made primarily from corn. Although the name "Bourbon" was applied in the 1850s, and the true Kentucky etymology was advanced by the 1870s, the invention or origin of bourbon is to date somewhat of a myth with varying stories.. from the invention by a pioneering Baptist minister and distiller named Elijah Craig, to it being named after Bourbon St in New Orleans, where the Tarascon bros very successfully sold their shipments of Kentucky whiskey as a cheaper alternative to French cognac. One thing we do know; we love to drink it.*

<b>BLENDED</b>		
<p><i>A blended scotch whisky may contain a combination of whiskies from over 40 or 50 different malt and grain distilleries. The normal ratio of malt to grain is 60% grain 40% malt. The percentage of malt used will determine the quality and smoothness of taste and character. Each whisky used in the blending process will normally have been matured for about 5 years, however there are a number of higher aged blended scotch whiskies available.</i></p>
